

# PROTECT! ICELANDIC ANIMALS



**DISEASES** can be transmitted to animals and man from food of animal origin. Please take utmost precautionary measures when importing food to Iceland!

**Importing the following foodstuffs is strictly prohibited:**



- Raw meat, including salami and smoked ham
- Raw eggs
- Unpasteurized milk products

**The following products are permitted:**

Boiled or processed foodstuffs, provided the packaging clearly specifies heat treatment.

## PROTECT ICELANDIC FRESHWATER FISH!



Infectious disease agents such as viruses and the parasite, *Gyrodactylus salaris*, have never been detected in freshwater fish in Iceland.

**Importing the following equipment is strictly prohibited:**

Used fishing equipment such as fishing rods, reels, hooks/lures/flyes, waders and nets, unless it has been disinfected by approved methods.

**Disinfection:**

Disinfection must be carried out by a veterinarian from the country of embarkation and a certificate of disinfection presented when transporting the equipment to Iceland. If a certificate cannot be obtained, the fishing equipment must be handed to customs officers upon entering the country for immediate disinfection at owner's expense.



**Visitors are asked to adopt strict biosecurity measures!**
